





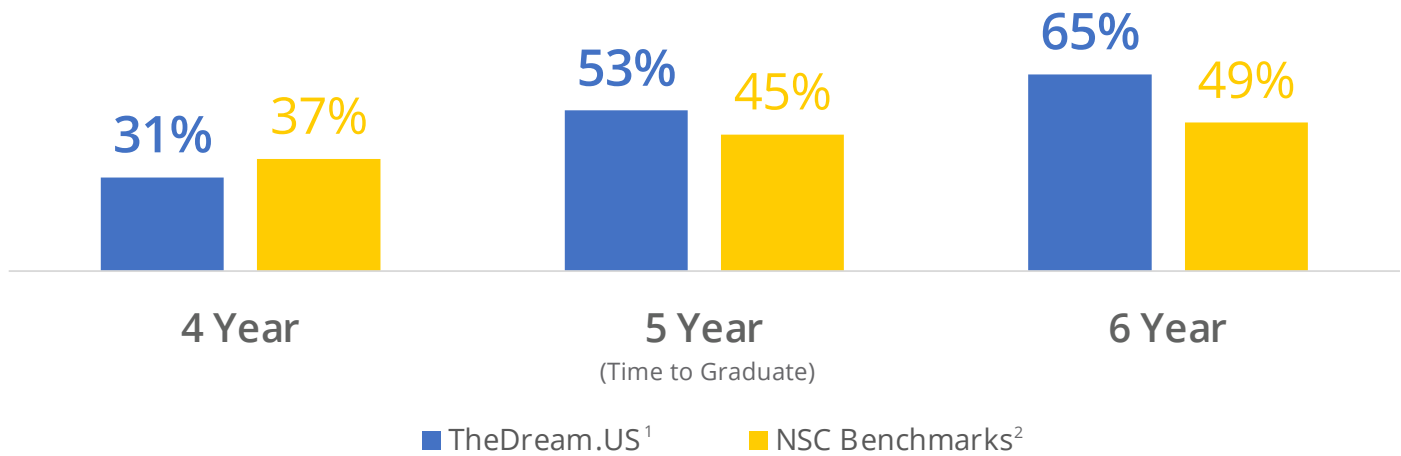

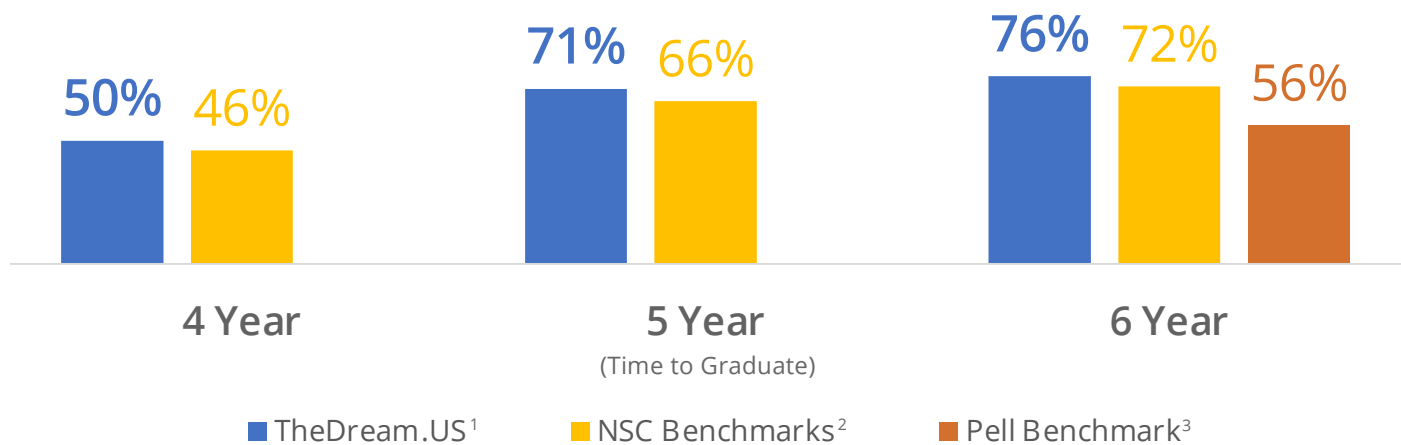
National Scholars Starting at 2-Year Colleges

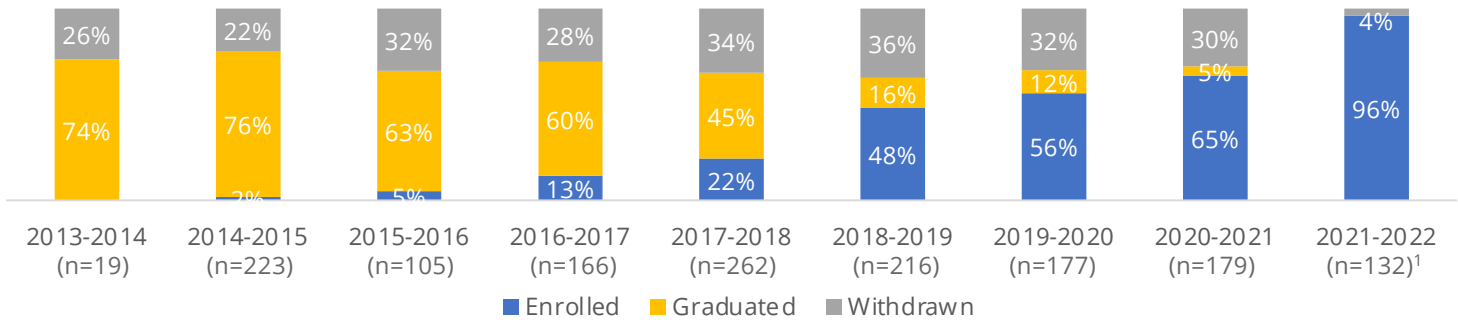

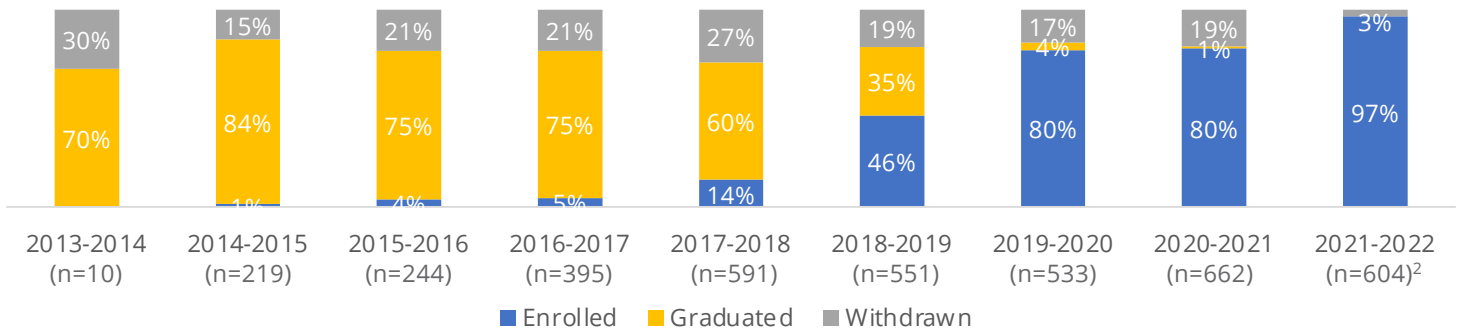
Overall Persistence by Scholarship Type and Academic Year Cohort

72% for First-Time College Students starting at 2-Year Colleges (N=1,479)



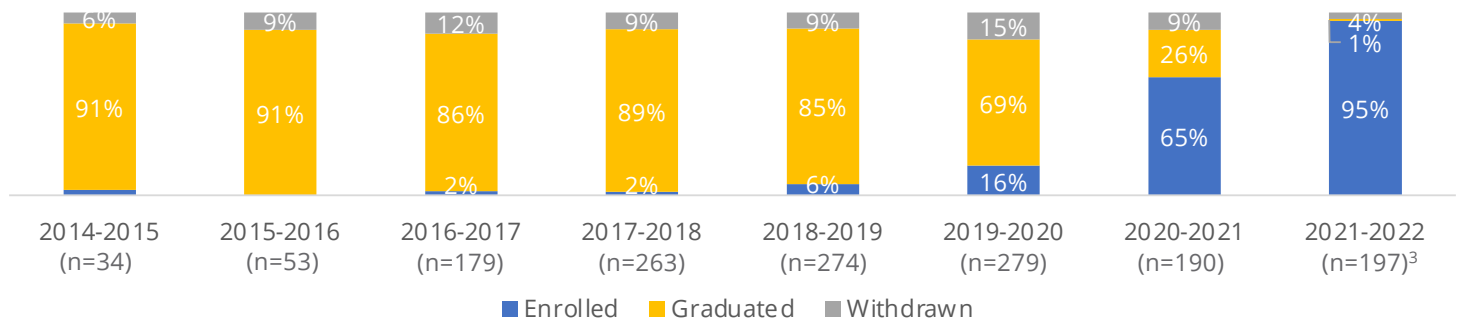
